



**Holy Family School System  
Iowa Assessment Results Fall 2017**

The Iowa Assessments measure student achievement and growth across the continuum of next generation learning standards, including the Common Core State Standards. The top three charts reflect the grade equivalency of Holy Family students taking the IA Assessments in the second month of the school year. Therefore, 3.2 means a third grader taking the test in the second month of school. The use of standard scores (Charts A & B) allows us to see growth of our students each year.
